Inspired by the starry night, Félix Solís wanted to create a wine that captures the joyful and vibrant spirit of the Spaniards. He named this wine Albali, after a star in the constellation of Aquarius.

Regionen

The region of Castile – La Mancha, which extends across the central highlands of the Spanish mainland, is the largest continuous wine-growing area in the world. Both single-varietal wines as well as grape juices, musts and sangrias are produced in this fantastic wine region. Airén and Tempranillo are the two most typical grape varieties of this region.

Verkostungsnotizen

Through natural fermentation, a perfect balance is achieved between alcohol, acidity and sweetness, resulting in a fruity, sweet and refreshing character with light carbon dioxide and low alcohol content.

Speiseempfehlung

It goes very well with fresh, light cuisine, especially with fish and seafood, from sushi to squid.

Technische Information

Produced from white Verdejo grapes, which are harvested at night and cold macerated to optimally extract the characteristic aromas of the grape variety. After a gentle pressing, it is fermented at a controlled temperature (below 13 °C) to preserve its freshness and its fruity character.
