Inspired by the starry night, Félix Solís wanted to create a wine that reflects the joyful and lively spirit of the Spaniards. He named this wine Albali, after a star in the constellation Aquarius.

Regionen

Like France's Vins de Pays, the Vino de la Tierra de Castilla is a geographical designation in Spain, for wines that come from the autonomous region of Castilla-La Mancha. The calcareous and clayey soils are located at an altitude of 700 meters and it rains rarely.

Verkostungsnotizen

This wine has complex aromas of plum and black cherry. The palate is rich and well-defined with soft tannins, which contribute to this elegant and balanced wine.

Speiseempfehlung

Perfect accompaniment to beef, wild (deer or rabbit), rice dishes, pork and lamb dishes.

Technische Information

The ripening of the grapes is carefully monitored to create a balanced, structured wine with perfect sugar and acid levels. The wine is subjected to cold maceration, usually for 3 or 4 days. The 8-day fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperature. The wine should be enjoyed as a young wine.
