Like France's Vins de Pays, Vino de la Tierra de Castilla is a Spanish geographical indication for wines located in the autonomous region of Castile La Mancha. The limestone and argillaceous soils are at an altitude of 700 metres and rain fall is scarce.

Pale yellow in colour The nose has intense aromas of flowers and white fruits. The palate has a creamy softness with hints of herbs and citrics.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Grapes are picked at their optimum ripeness to obtain a well-balanced wine with just the right levels of sweetness and acidity. Fermentation takes place at a controlled temperature of 14-16 °C in stainless steel tanks for up to 10-12 days.

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
