Region

The area of Castilla-La Mancha, located in the central plateau of the Iberian Peninsula, is the world's largest vineyard. Varietal wines, grape juice and sangrias are produced in this vast wine region. Airen and Tempranillo are the most typical grapes from this area.

Technical Information

The Verdejo grapes are harvested at dawn in early October. Cool night temperatures allow the grapes to retain their wonderful aromatic nature. Partially-fermented grape must is in isobaric tanks where fine bubbles are naturally formed. When the wine-must come to 5.5 degrees of alcohol, it stops the fermentation.
