

Like France's Vins de Pays, Vino de la Tierra de Castilla is a Spanish geographical indication for wines located in the autonomous region of Castile La Mancha. The limestone and argillaceous soils are at an altitude of 700 metres and rain fall is scarce.

TASTING NOTES

Pale yellow in colour with golden hues. The nose has intense aromas of apple, peach, fennel and tropical fruits. The palate has a creamy softness with hints of stone fruit. A lovely, dean, fresh and sweet finish.

i TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Grapes are picked at their optimum ripeness to obtain a well-balanced wine with just the right levels of sweetness and acidity. The wine undergoes a short period of cold maceration that lasts for around 6 hours. Fermentation takes place at a controlled temperature of 14-16°C in stainless steel tanks for up to 12-15 days. It is followed by a short period of maturation, resulting in an elegant, fresh and fruity wine.
