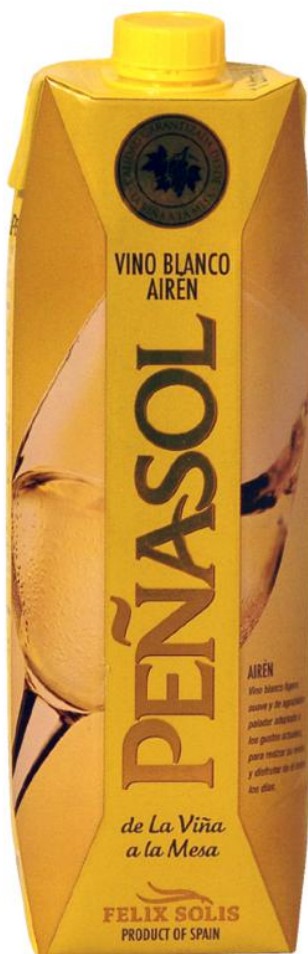


Peñasol White Semi Sweet Prisma

Semi sweet white Peñasol takes its name of the place where it is made: the sunny Valley of the Stones, old name of Valdepeñas, the valley of the river Jabalon. The wine is made of airen grapes, the autochthonous grape from Castilla- La Mancha.

The area of Castilla - La Mancha, located in the central plateau of the Iberian Peninsula, is the world's largest vineyard. Varietal wines are made with one type of grape. Airén and tempranillo are the most characteristic grapes of this area.
