This wine is made from "albariño" grapes carefully grown in the vineyars of the región "Val do Salnés" (Salnes Valley) in Galicia, where there is concentrated the largest area of vineyards and wineries Denominación de Origen Rías Baixas.

This grape is characterized by small clusters, early maturing and medium vigor. They noted for its floral and fruity, fine and distinguished aromas, which pleasantly impressed, medium intensity and medium-long term.

These lowlands near the sea are related to the lower stretches of river courses with a climate characterized by mild temperatures and a decrease of rainfall during the summer months.

The wine is bright, pale lemon in colour with hints of apple green. Aromas of white flowers, hints of peaches and apricots lead to a fresh, fruity palate and an enjoyable finish.
