

Brimming with tradition, D.O. Toro is an exciting wine region nestled in the heart of Castilla y Léon, in the province of Zamora, northern Spain. The appellation is next door to Rueda, and not far from Ribera del Duero and Rioja. It is one of Spain's best kept secrets. The wines have a long history, dating back to the Roman settlements. In the middle ages, the wines enjoyed Royal privileges that allowed them to be exclusively sold in towns and cities. Even Christopher Columbus is said to have taken the wines of Toro on his expeditions to America. Toro was classified as Denominación de Origen (D.O.) status in 1987. With its ancient vines, is certainly one of Spain's most promising regions for the production of red wines of impressive quality.

✗ TASTING NOTES

Deep cherry red in colour with purple hues. This wine exhibits aromas of red fruits and fruit of the forest. On the palate it is fruity with a long-lasting finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Perfect with tapas, white beans in garlic and tomato, with roast beef or lamb over a long, lazy lunch, or with a rich Spanish chorizo stew for dinner.

i TECHNICAL INFORMATION

The Tinta de Toro and Garnacha grapes are harvested from the end of September through to October. The grapes are then fermented separately in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature of 24-26°C to maximise the extraction of flavour and colour.
