Condado de Oriza Red is made from Tinta del País (Tempranillo) grapes that are carefully selected from vines grown on gravelly clay loam soils in Ribera del Duero.

REGION
In the last 30 years, D.O. Ribera del Duero has emerged to challenge for the crown of Spain's greatest wine region. Located in Spain's northern plateau, it covers four of Castilla y León's provinces – Burgos, Segovia, Soria and Valladolid. But, unlike its name-sake, it does not cover all of the River Duero that unites more than 100 villages. Ribera del Duero was granted its D.O. in 1982. Today it has over 250 wineries and over 22,000 ha of vines. Most of Ribera del Duero's production is red with only a modest quantity of rosado produced. No white wines are allowed under the D.O. yet, but they will be allowed soon. The region is characterised by a largely flat, rocky terrain.

TASTING NOTES
Bright crimson in colour with purple hues. On the nose, a scent of ripe, red fruits, including red currants, blackberries and cherries, paired with, sweet and floral notes. On the palate, the wine is very fruity with sour cherry flavours, well-integrated tannins and acidity and a long fresh finish.

FOOD PAIRING
A perfect companion to grilled and braised meats, casseroles, pasta with red sauce or beef and vegetable rice dishes like paella.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION
The grapes are carefully selected before embarking on a further 2-day maceration process. The must is fermented at a controlled temperature (22 °C) to ensure the optimal varietal expression, its characteristic colour and polished tannins. The bottles are then aged in our cellar for 4 months.
